



[Activating KIS 2009](#)

During installation, Kaspersky Internet Security (KIS) will ask to activate the program. You can also activate the program later with an [Activation code \(license key\)](#), for example if you first chose to activate the 30 day demo then later purchased a license.

If you do not already have an *Activation code (license key)*, you may [purchase these at a discount from Aussie PC Fix](#) or [contact us](#), or buy online at full price from <https://estore.kaspersky.com.au>

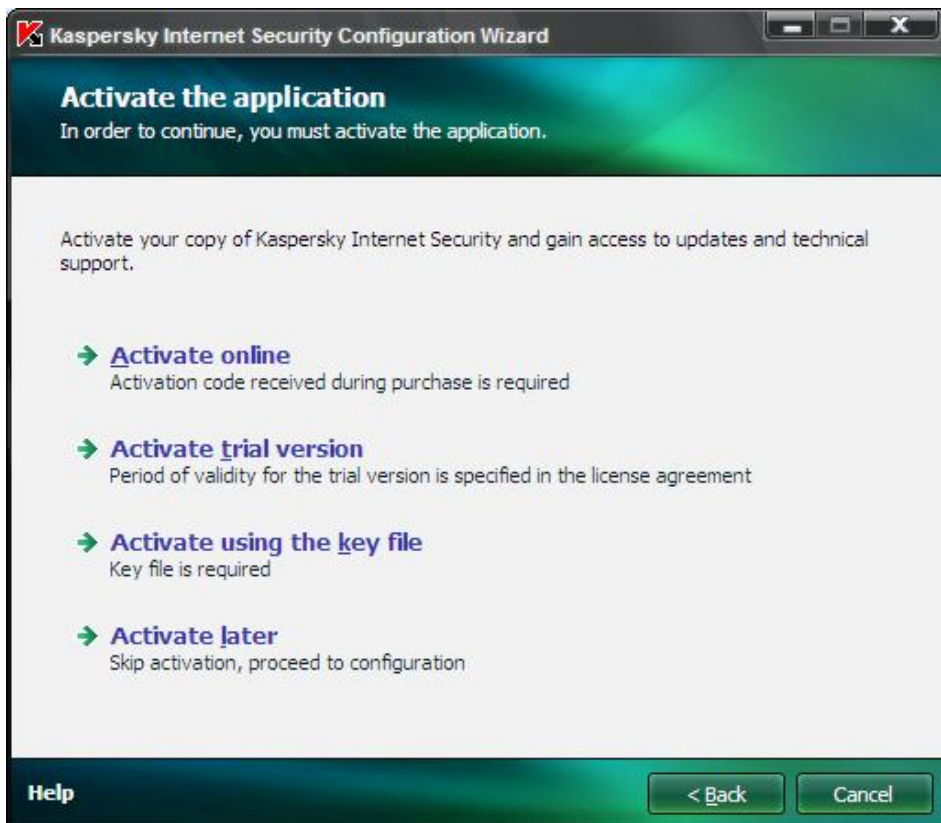
If you are installing **KIS 2009**, click **Next** to proceed when you see this screen during installation.



If you have already installed KIS then open the program (click on the  near your clock!) and click on **License**, then **Activate the application** to get to the next screen



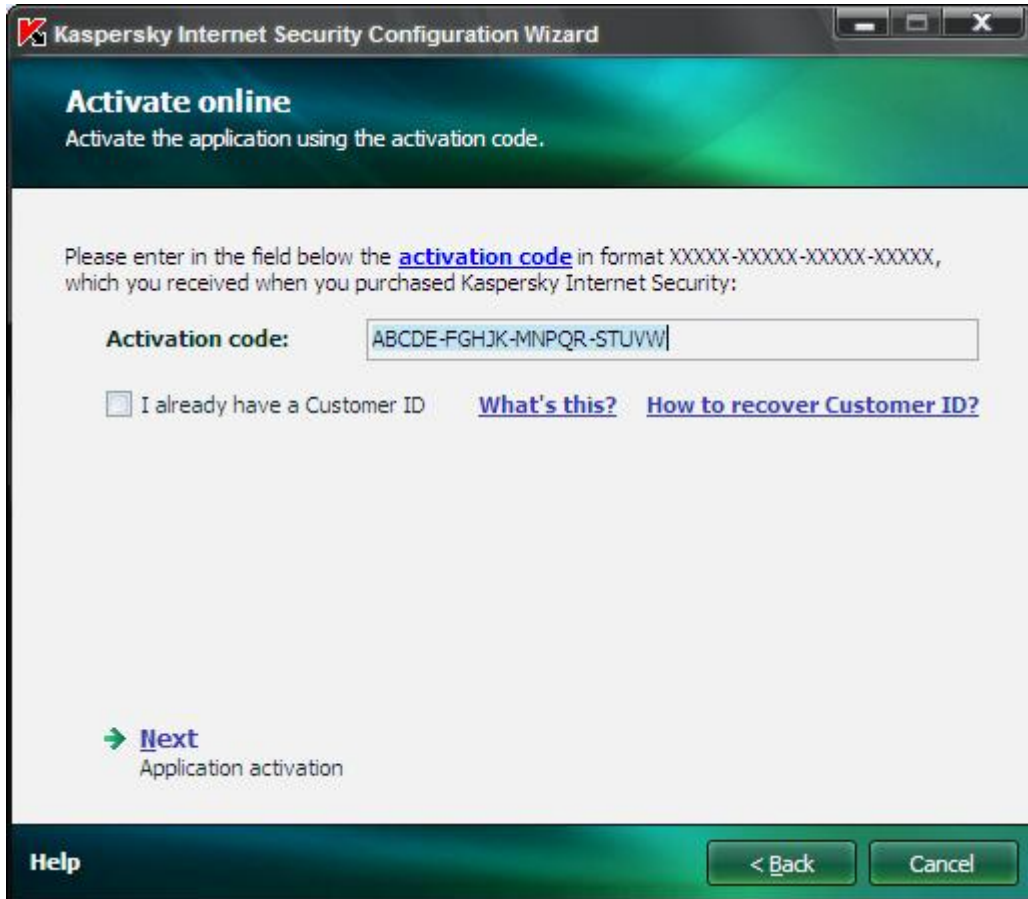
Once you have an [Activation code \(license key\)](#), then you can **Activate online** (Select the first option, not the third “key file” option!)



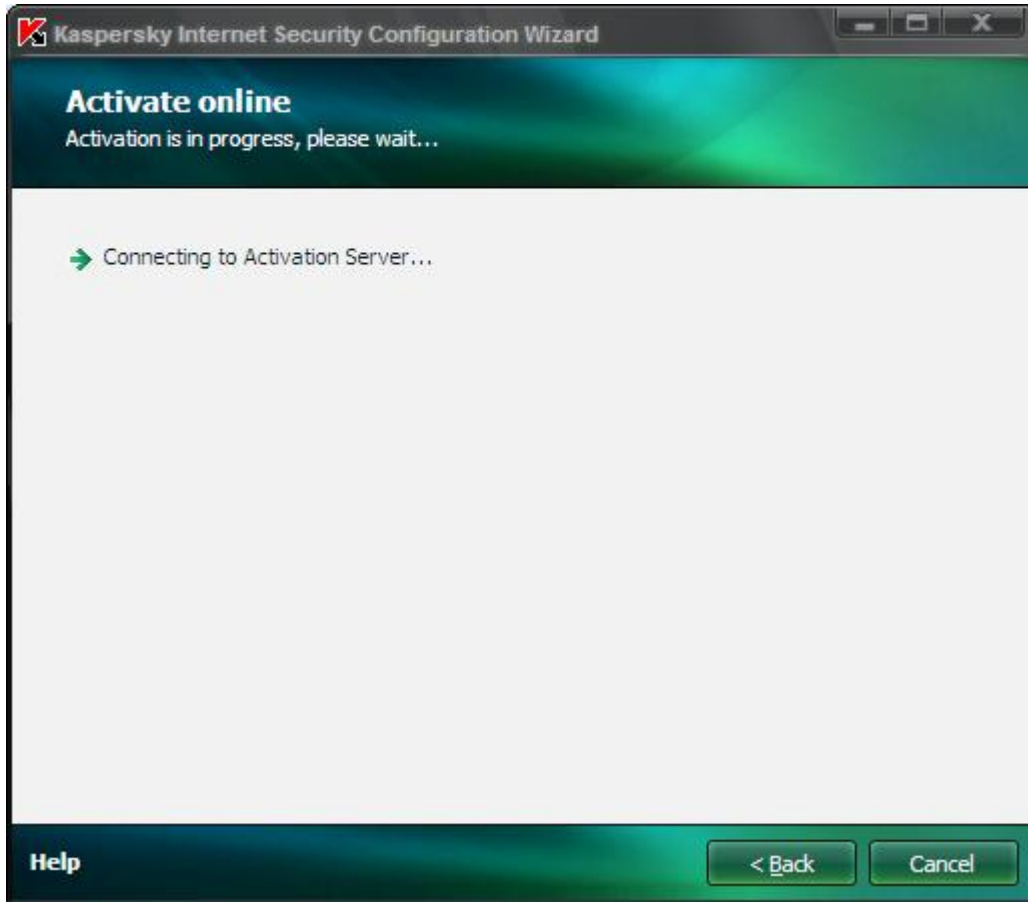
If you do not yet have an Activation Code, then you may either:

- Activate trial version** (for 30 days), or
- Activate later** (program will not update properly)

Copy and paste your **Activation code** into the space provided. Make sure you are connected to the Internet and click **Next**



KIS will contact the *Activation Server* and activate you license.
